

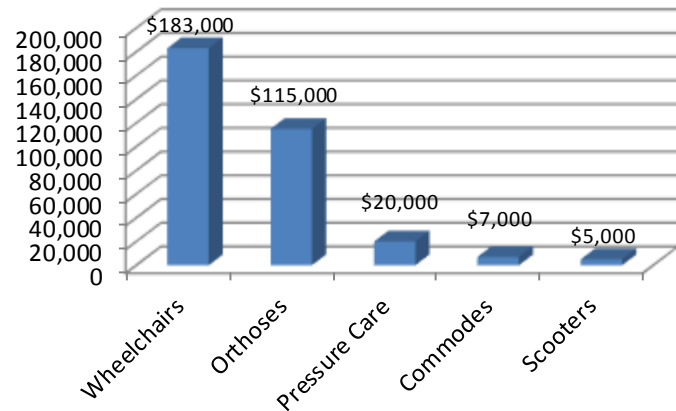
The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Continence Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP), Specialist Equipment Library (SEL) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of October 2015. Every month we will provide information about each program.

### A&E CHILDREN

**This month we have:**

- Processed 271 applications
- Allocated over \$400,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 187 clients with the purchase of 349 items

### A&E ADULTS

**This month we have:**

- Processed 1035 applications
- Allocated over \$1,500,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 826 clients with the purchase of 1509 items

### DOP

**This month we have:**

- Processed 154 applications
- Allocated over \$390,000 towards equipment
- 3591 clients receiving oxygen

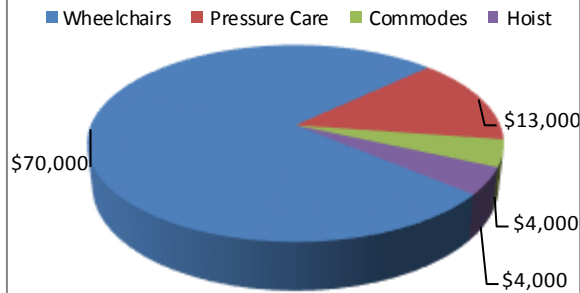
### CONTINENCE

**This month we have:**

- Processed 836 applications
- Allocated over \$280,000 towards continence aids
- 699 clients receiving continence aids

## REISSUE

This month we've reissued 259 items to 207 unique clients. We currently have 332 reissue-able items in our warehouse and 144 collected items that are pending assessment.

## REPAIRS

Chemtronics repaired 828 items of equipment in October. Of these repairs 311 were Powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 37.5% of total repairs.

## VMSS

### This month we have:

Allocated over \$100,000 towards modifications.

Majority of modifications were:

- Contribution to Modification - \$10,000
- Lowered Floor Conversions - \$39,000
- Seating Modification - \$16,000

## NDIS

### This month we have:

- Processed 305 applications
- Allocated over \$650,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 111 clients by allocating funding towards 297 items
