

SWEP PERFORMANCE REPORT CARD

October 2016



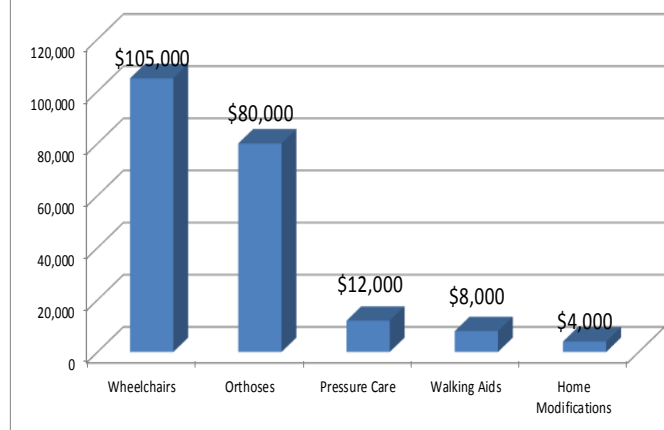
The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Continence Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of October 2016. Every month we will provide information about each program.

AIDS & EQUIPMENT CHILDREN + TFC

This month we have:

- Processed 278 applications
- Allocated over \$380,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 128 clients with the purchase of 341 items

A&E ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 880 applications
- Allocated over \$1,000,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 419 clients with the purchase of 1356 items

DOP

This month we have:

- Processed 182 applications
- Allocated over \$390,000 towards equipment
- 3481 clients receiving oxygen

CONTINENCE

This month we have:

- Processed 806 applications
- Allocated over \$260,000 towards continence aids
- 606 clients receiving continence aids

SAEAS

This month we have:

Allocated over \$190,000 towards equipment.

Majority of equipment funded:

- Wheelchairs - \$45,000
- Beds - \$12,000
- Hoists - \$11,000

REISSUE


This month we've reissued 207 Items to 152 unique clients. We currently have 22 reissue-able items in our warehouse and 60 collected items that are pending assessment.

REPAIRS

Chemtronics assisted 948 clients and repaired 1102 items of equipment. Of these repairs 385 were Powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 35% of the repairs.

NDIS

This month we have:

- Processed 312 applications
- Allocated over \$500,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 114 clients by allocating funding towards 422 items
