


The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Continence Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of October 2017. Every month we will provide information about each program.

AIDS & EQUIPMENT CHILDREN

This month we have:

- Processed 163 applications
- Allocated \$164,000 over towards equipment
- Assisted 77 clients with the purchase of 203 items



A&E ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 762 applications
- Allocated over \$718,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 447 clients with the purchase of 986 items

DOP

This month we have:

- Processed 162 applications
- Allocated over \$387,000
 towards equipment
- 3310 clients receiving

oxygen

CONTINENCE

This month we have:

- Processed 811 applications
- Allocated over \$286,000 towards continence aids
- 750 clients receiving continence aids

SAEAS

This month we have:

Allocated over \$53,000 towards equipment.

Majority of equipment funded:

- Wheelchairs \$ 11,000
- Slings \$ 2,000
- Pressure Care \$ 2,000

REISSUE

This month we've reissued 165 Items to 130 unique

clients. We currently have 349 reissue-able items

in our warehouse and 336 collected items that are


pending assessment.

REPAIRS

Chemtronics has repaired 1273 items of equipment this month.

Of these repairs 470 were Powered wheelchairs.

Powered wheelchairs made 37% up of the repairs.



SWEP SURVEY RESULTS

NDIS

This month we have:

- Processed 677 applications
- Allocated over \$ 1,252,679 towards equipment
- Allocated funding towards 1095 items
