2017



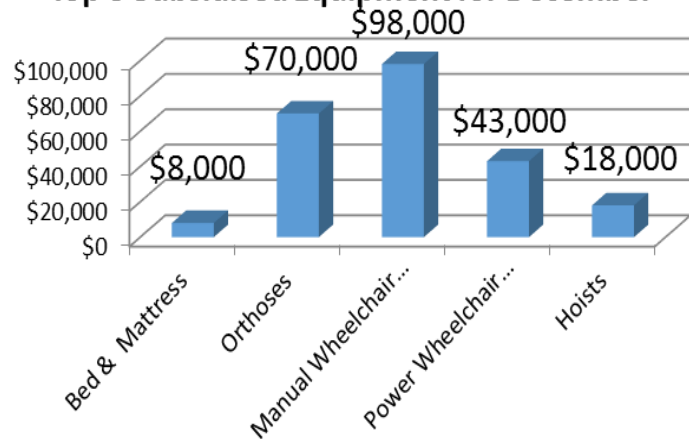
The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Contenance Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of December 2017. Every month we will provide information about each program.

AIDS & EQUIPMENT CHILDREN

This month we have:

- Processed 136 applications
- Allocated over \$300,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 125 clients with the purchase of 247 items

A&E ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 611 applications
- Allocated \$823,805.00 over towards equipment
- Assisted 510 clients with the purchase of 1102 items

DOP

This month we have:

- Processed 130 applications
- Allocated \$390,000 over towards equipment
- 3170 Clients receiving oxygen

CONTINENCE

This month we have:

- Processed 633 applications
- Allocated over \$160,000 towards continence aids
- 308 Clients receiving continence aids

SAEAS

This month we have:

Allocated over \$159,000 towards equipment.

Majority of equipment funded:

- Wheelchairs - \$73,000
- Orthotics - \$7,000
- Pressure Care - \$15,000

REISSUE

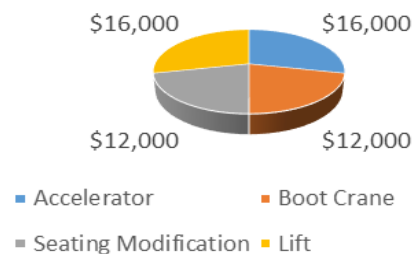
This month we've reissued 190 items to 183 unique clients. We currently have 448 reissue-able items in our warehouse and collected 260 items that are pending assessment.

REPAIRS

Chemtronics has repaired 787 items of equipment this month. Of these repairs 353 were Powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 44% of the repairs.

- Processed 688 applications
- Allocated over \$1,280,330 towards equipment
- Allocated funding towards 1124 items
