SWEP PERFORMANCE REPORT CARD 2018




The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Continence Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of January 2018. Every month we will provide information about each program.

AIDS & EQUIPMENT ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 567 applications
- Allocated over \$1,207,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 580 clients with the purchase of 856 items of equipment



A&E CHILDREN & TFC

This month we have:

- Processed 129 applications
- Allocated over \$419,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 210 clients with the purchase of 147 Re-Issuable items

REPAIRS


Chemtronics has repaired 1076 items of equipment this month. Of these repairs 393 were Powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 36% of the repairs.

CONTINENCE AIDS

This month we have:

- Processed 800 applications
- Allocated over \$163,000 towards continence aids
- 282 clients receiving continence aids





VMSS

This month we have:

Allocated over \$43,500 towards modifications
Majority of modifications were:

- Passenger / Driver—Seating Modification
- Passenger / Driver—Roof Hoist
- Driver—Accelerator Modification

DOMICILIARY OXYGEN

This month we have:

- Processed 109 applications
- Allocated over \$422,400 towards
 equipment
- 3659 clients receiving oxygen

REISSUE

This month we've reissued 146 Items to 102 unique clients. We currently have 182 reissue-able items in our warehouse and collected items that are pending assessment.

NDIS

This month we have:

- Processed 755 applications
- Allocated over \$ 1,000,000 towards equipment
- Allocated funding towards 1184 items
