March 2018



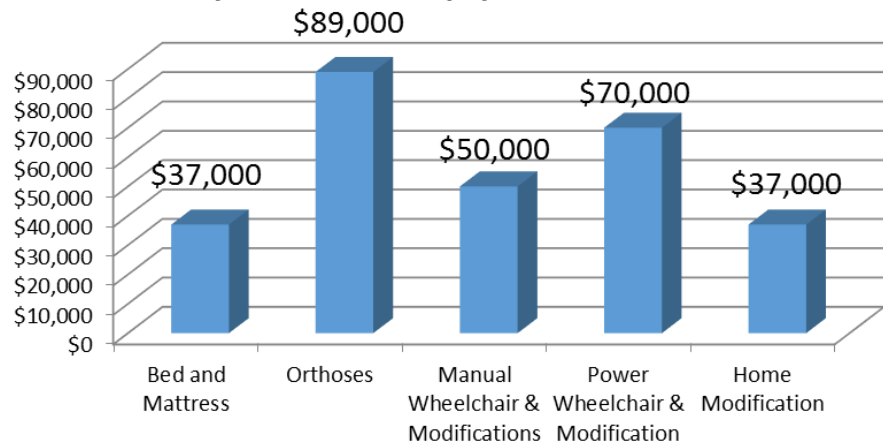
The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen, Contenance Aids, Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of March 2018. Every month we will provide information about each program.

AIDS & EQUIPMENT ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 889 applications
- Allocated over \$616,400 towards equipment
- Assisted 462 clients with the purchase of 1209 items of equipment

A&E CHILDREN & TFC

This month we have:

- Processed 146 applications
- Allocated over \$280,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 101 clients with the purchase of 177 items

REPAIRS

Chemtronics has repaired 959 items of equipment this month. Of these repairs 330 were Powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 34% of the repairs.

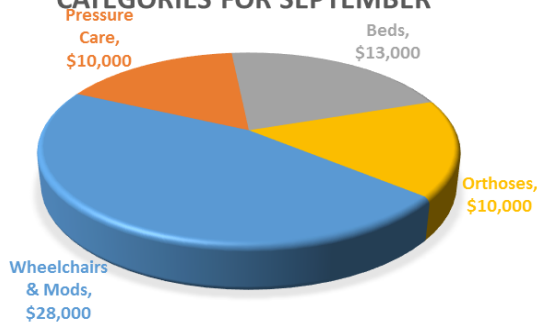
CONTINENCE AIDS

This month we have:

- Processed 693 applications
- Allocated over \$180,000 towards continence aids
- 194 clients receiving continence aids

VMSS

This month we have:

- Allocated over \$50,000 towards equipment

Majority of modifications were:

- Wheelchair Lifts - \$21,000
- Boot Crane - \$17,000
- Seating Modifications - \$12,000

DOMICILIARY OXYGEN

This month we have:

- Processed 137 applications
- Allocated over \$386,000 towards equipment
- 3282 clients receiving oxygen

REISSUE

This month we've reissued 183 Items to 137 unique clients. We currently have 453 reissue-able items in our warehouse and collected 147 items that are pending assessment.

SWEP LCGP

This month we have:

- Processed 103 Orders
- Allocated over \$15,000 towards garments
- Allocated funding towards 141 garments
- There is currently no waitlist for the LCGP

NDIS

This month we have:

- Processed 854 applications
- Allocated over \$1,483,700 towards equipment
- Allocated funding towards 1379 items
