
SWEP PERFORMANCE REPORT CARD

June 2018



The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged and/or with a long term disability. Under this umbrella there are many subprograms that deal with different equipment and client groups including: Domiciliary Oxygen Program (DOP), Continence Aids (CA), Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS), Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS), Reissue, Repairs, National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), Child and Adult Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP), Community Equipment Program (CEP) and the Top-up Fund for Children (TFC), Lymphoedema Compression Garment Program (LCGP). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of June 2018. Every month we will provide information about each program.



A&E ADULTS

This month we have:

- Processed 751 applications
- Allocated over \$1,522,000 towards equipment
- Assisted 903 clients with the purchase of 1,146 items

DOP

This month we have:

- Processed 126 applications
- Allocated over \$213,500 towards equipment
- 3,222 clients receiving oxygen

CONTINENCE

This month we have:

- Processed 660 applications
- Allocated over \$493,000 towards continence aids
- 1,018 clients receiving continence aids



SAEAS

This month we have:

Allocated over \$47,000 towards equipment.

Majority of equipment funded:


- Wheelchairs \$12,000
- Beds \$7,000
- Pressure Care \$7,000

REISSUE

This month we've reissued 197 Items to 149 unique clients. We currently have 564 reissue-able items in our warehouse and collected 66 items that are pending assessment.

REPAIRS

Chemtronics has repaired 934 items of equipment this month. Of these repairs 316 were powered wheelchairs. Powered wheelchairs made up 33% of the repairs.



LCGP

This month we have:

- Processed 115 Orders
- Allocated over \$14,000 towards garments
- Allocated funding towards 148 garments

NDIS

This month we have:

- Processed 883 applications
- Allocated over \$1,831,850 towards equipment
- Allocated funding towards 1,518 items
