

# SWEP PERFORMANCE REPORT CARD

## July 2018



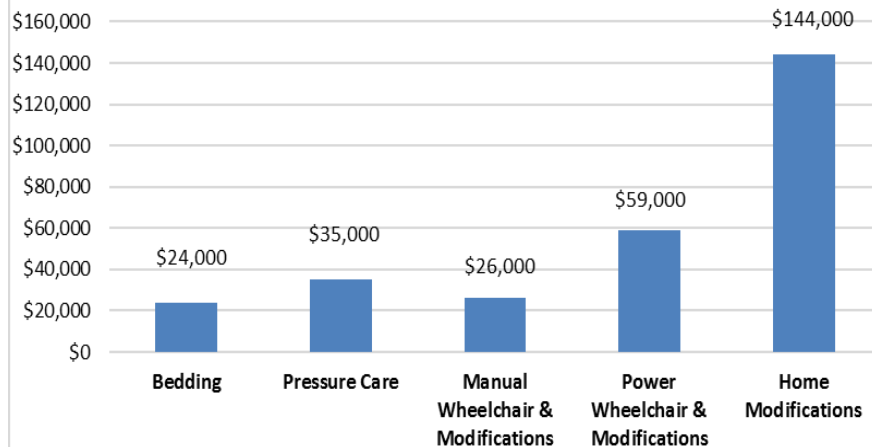
The State-wide Equipment Program (SWEP) aims to provide subsidised aids and equipment for Victorian residents who are frail aged (and living independently) and/or with a long term disability. There are many subprograms for different types of equipment including: Aids & Equipment Program (A&EP Adults & Children); Top-up Fund for Children (TFC); Repairs; Contenance Aids (CA); Domiciliary Oxygen (DOP); Supported Accommodation Equipment Assistance Scheme (SAEAS); Vehicle Modification Subsidy Scheme (VMSS); Reissue; National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS); Community Equipment Program (CEP); Lymphoedema Compression Garments Program (LCGP) and Laryngectomy Consumables Program (LCP). Below is a basic breakdown of the achievements each program has made in the month of July 2018.

### A&EP ADULT

#### This month we have:

- Received 411 applications for adults requiring assistance.
- Assisted 377 adults with funding towards their equipment.
- Assisted with the purchase of 511 individual items of equipment.

### A&EP CHILD & TFC

#### This month we have:

- Received 32 applications for children requiring assistance.
- Assisted 44 children with funding towards their equipment.
- Assisted with the purchase of 40 individual items of equipment.

### REPAIRS

Our contracted Supplier for Repairs (Chemtronics) have attended to repairs of 943 items of equipment this month.

The most common items repaired this month were Scooters and Powered Wheelchairs

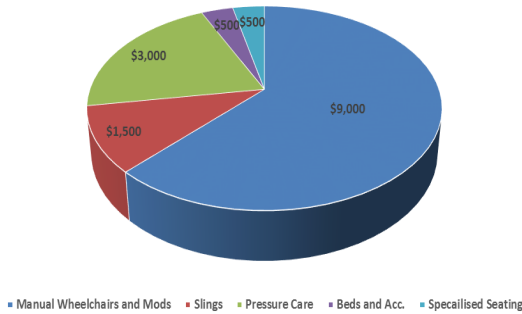
### CONTINENCE AIDS

#### This month we have:

- Received 655 applications for people requiring assistance.
- Assisted 566 people with funding towards their continence products.

## VMSS

### This month we have:

- Received 2 applications for people requiring assistance.
- Assisted 4 people with funding towards their vehicle modification.

Most common modifications are for Boot Cranes and Lowered Floor Conversions.

## DOP

### This month we have:

- Received 126 new applications for people requiring assistance.
- Assisted 3,170 people receiving oxygen.

## REISSUE

This month we have reissued 175 refurbished items to people requiring assistance.

We currently have 575 refurbished items in our warehouse and have collected 89 items that are no longer required and are pending refurbishment.

## SWEP LCGP

### This month we have:

- Received 140 applications for people requiring assistance.
- Assisted 146 people with funding towards their garments.
- Assisted with the purchase of 172 individual garments.

## NDIS

### This month we have:

- Received 978 applications for NDIS eligible participants.
- Assisted with the purchase of 836 items of equipment for 315 NDIS participants.
