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Picklists

The State-Wide Equipment Program (SWEP) generates and maintains picklists for the use of SWEP registered Practitioners. All picklists are generated with the input and rationalisation of the SWEP Clinical Advisory Panels who are groups of clinicians with expertise in prescription of equipment and at least ten years' experience in their area. There is a Clinical Advisory Panel for Children and one for Adults. Within each panel, there are sub-specialties for each equipment category.

All items on this quotable pick list require quotes and specifications to accompany the application.

Please note that some items may require co-contribution's due to SWEP subsidy funding levels. Items such as pressure care cushions are subject to subsidy timeframe limitations and a client who has previously accessed an item may have an altered co-contribution requirement.
